The Govt. of India, Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, Krishi Bhawan, New Delhi vide letter No. 1-8/2013-BP-III- (Vol.II) dated 21.02.2017 has allocated 6,956.857 MT Rice (AAY=2,627.888 MTs, PH= 4,328.969 MTs) under NFSA. Quantity of 8,492.824 MTs of Rice under Tide over allocation for consumers other than NFSA has also been allotted.

The District wise/PDC wise sub allocation for the month of February, 2020 has been made as per enclosed Annexure. The financial arrangement in this regard shall be made by the Managing Director, H.P. State Civil Supplies Corporation Ltd., Shimla. No diversion of quantity in the allocation be made except with prior approval of the undersigned.

It is, therefore, requested that FAQ stocks may be made available at each PDC and the supplies made to the HP State Civil Supplies Corporation Ltd. before the validity period.

The sale rate of OTNFSA Rice in Tribal and Non-Tribal areas of the State will remain **Rs 10.00 per kg**.
